- Have typical plaque psoriasis in other areas of your body
- Have moderate-to-severe plaque psoriasis on your whole body
- Did not respond or are intolerant to at least 1 topical therapy

The study doctor will also check additional eligibility requirements.

What else should I know?

If you decide to take part in the study, all study-related drugs and procedures will be provided to you at no cost. Participation is voluntary and you would be able to leave the study at any point without penalty.
